2. The Pedigree and descriptions of the lots are believed to be correct, but are not intended as a warranty, and therefore shall be taken with all faults and errors of description.
3. The Ewes and Gimmers are sold as having been running with the Rams and are not guaranteed in lamb.
4. All Female Sheep are sold as correct in teats unless otherwise intimated.
5. All Sheep are sold as correct in teeth unless otherwise intimated.
6. Any complaint on Conditions 4 & 5 must be intimated in Sale Pens, otherwise no claim will be entertained.
7. All purchases to be paid to the Auctioneers. If purchasers fail to pay and remove their purchases as stated the Exposers or Auctioneers reserve full power to re-sell the same, either publicly or privately, without further intimation, and any loss arising from such re-sale, together with keep and all other expenses, must be made good by the defaulters at this Sale who, by bidding, bind themselves to implement the same.
8. Immediately after each purchase is declared, the risk of the animal shall be exclusively with the purchaser.
9. No undertaking of the Auctioneers or their Servants to take charge of the Lots or Animals after the Sale, or to forward them to their destination, shall be held to impose upon the Auctioneers any legal obligation to vitiate any of the foregoing Conditions.
10. Notwithstanding the above conditions, all sheep are offered subject to the Conditions of Sale as recommended by the Livestock Market Committee of England & Wales.

### PEDIGREE SHEEP ONLY

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1. All Vendors must be Members of the West Country Suffolk Sheep Association and have paid their subscriptions for the current year.
2. All animals entered for sale must be registered with the Breed Society and must be bona fide the property of the Exhibitor.
3. The sale has been authorised to include sheep from DEFRA, accredited flocks, they will be segregated as far as penning is concerned and sold first.
4. The Sale will be held subject to the Conditions of Sale approved by the Livestock Auctioneers Markets Committee. A full copy of these Conditions will be displayed in the Auctioneers Sale Office.
5. Vendors will be held responsible for correct earmarking, and ensuring that the breeding of ewes is correct (and to declare state of udders). The Committee reserve the right to inspect Sheep at random
6. Vendors have a right to fix a Reserve Price for any or all of their animals but any such reserve price must be notified to the Auctioneers at least ½ an hour before the start of the sale.
7. All Pedigree Ewes will be sold in guineas and a commission of 5p in the guinea will be charged by the Auctioneers on all sales. No animal may be sold privately before being passed through the auction ring. Full commission will be charged on the sale of any animal sold by Private Treaty after the Auction and all such Transactions must be passed through the Auctioneers.
8. Substitutes will be allowed. Pedigree particulars must be available before sale and displayed in the relevant pen.
9. All accredited sheep entering the approved section must be accompanied by a Movement Certificate MV20b, or SH20.

**Deveronside Dell Boy** is sired by Meikleison Man of War. He is a massive ram and won Breed Champion at Devon County Show this year. He won Champion Stock ram in the Western area Flock Competition 2010 & 2008. He was Reserve Champion at the National Show 2008.

**Strathisla Blitz** is sired by the 25,000 gns. Edinburgh Champion Strathisla Speedson. He has grown into an impressive shearling breeding fleshy scopey lambs.

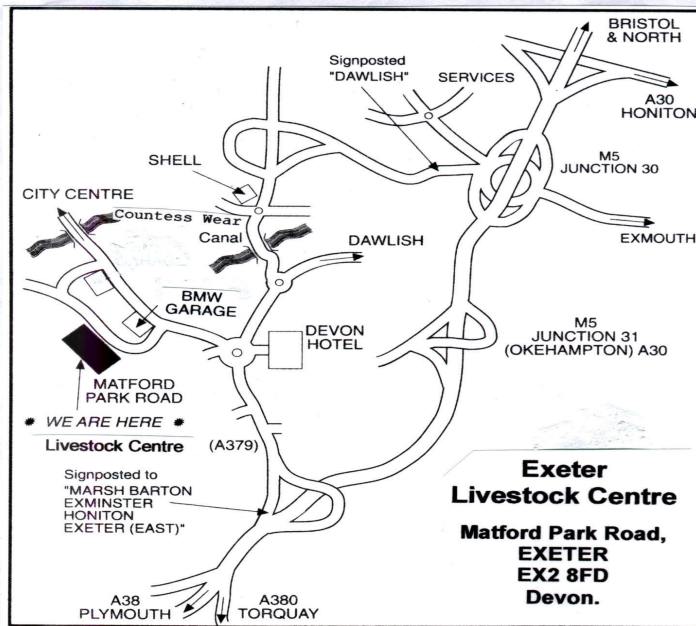
**Strathbeg Sea the Stars** is sired by Whitestone Warrior. Purchased at Edinburgh 2009. He is a cracking ram who was much admired at our view day last year and is breeding very well. .

**Deveronside Dynamite** is sired by Thurston Cheifton. A very correct ram with a big backend. He bred our best tup lamb last year that was Champion Lamb at the Royal Cornwall Show.

The Willmar flock won Champion Flock in both the Western area and Westcountry Flock competitions in 2010 and Reserve in the Keeble Cup (60-100 ewes) in the National Flock competition this year.

The flock is in the Heptavac P system and has been vaccinated with Toxovax.

These ewes have had no concentrates and are completely off grass. They have been treated as if we were to retain them and lamb them ourselves.



### DIRECTIONS FROM THE M5

Leave the M5 at junction 30, services exit, follow the slip road to the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto the dual carriageway towards Exeter (signposted "Dawlish").

Take the 3rd slip road, which filters onto a dual carriageway, follow to the roundabout with traffic light (Countess Wear), continue straight ahead.

Go over the Countess Wear swing bridge, continue to the next roundabout, ignore Dawlish turning taking the 2nd exit. Proceed to the next roundabout, the Devon Hotel will be on your left. Take the 4th exit signposted Marsh Barton.

Continue to the next roundabout, bear left. Proceed past Husseys Auction Centre and take the next turning on your left.

### DIRECTIONS FROM PLYMOUTH

Follow the A38 towards Exeter, take the A379 to Marsh Barton.

Follow the A379 to the roundabout, the Devon Hotel will be on your right, take the 2nd exit signposted Marsh Barton. follow this road to the next roundabout, and bear left. Proceed past Husseys Auction Centre and take the next turning on your left.
